2A Prepare Arms for Assembly.


NOTE: The hardware for these steps is included with the Arms. Some Arms may not have these features, so just skip these steps.

Fasten Stretcher Brackets to Arm.


- A. Insert the Stretcher Bracket Cleat into the hole provided.
- B. IMPORTANT: Don't fully tighten Bracket until Stretchers are all in place for easy alignment.
- C. Each arm requires two brackets, front and back.



Fit Wooden Dowels.



Tap dowels all the way into the middle hole, at each end of the Stretchers







3A Fit Back Deck into Position.


Your arm style may vary



- ▼ This step can be tricky it is best done with two people
- Remember that the Bolts on the Arm should be LOOSE.
- **X** Be careful not to scratch the Arms with the Plastic Runners when you lower the ends of the Back Deck.



B. When you have the Back Deck fitted lying flat, tighten all the Bolts. From the back, lift the Back Deck to upright as illustrated.




3B Fit Seat Deck into Position.


Fit the seat deck between the Arms and into the Back Deck as shown. Use the Clevis Pins to connect the two decks. Secure with a Washer and Locking Pin.


